Call to Order

Co-Chair Stevens called the meeting to order at 7:12 PM. Co-Chair Morris was absent for the reconvened meeting.

- II. Review of Minutes (November 20, 2024 and December 4, 2024) CM Gardner made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. CM Grellier seconded the motion. Both sets of minutes were approved as presented.
- III. Public Comment on Agenda Topics Three members of the public were in attendance.





Kit Burns provided public comment on City design standards.

IV. Business Items

2025 Draft Transportation and Mobility Plan: Project Prioritization Criteria (Discussion) – Jennifer Kammerzell, Public Works

Jennifer began the presentation by reviewing the status of the current TMP project list breaking down how many were completed, funded, and partially completed. She explained new projects were being added by using the TMP modal maps. Jennifer then reviewed the draft project prioritization criteria and noted changes from when staff previously presented in November. The Commission had expressed interest in weighting the criteria for equity. Jennifer and Carrie provided an example of what the project scoring would look like with no weighting, if equity was weighted, and if safety and equity were weighted. After seeing the results and feeling that equity was strongly captured throughout the scoring criteria, the Commission decided to not weight any of the criteria.

Carrie provided an overview of the Comprehensive Plan – TMP Update timeline. She suggested the Transportation Commission provide comment on the One Tacoma Comprehensive Plan focusing on alignment with the TMP. Commissioners offered to review and provide comment at the February meeting on the *following sections:*

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


CM Gardner provided a report on the existing and proposed Water Flume Line Trail project.
