Black tupelo (*Nyssa sylvatica*)

Dove tree (*Davidia involucrata*)
Serviceberry (*Amelanchier sp.*)
Sourwood (*Oxydendrum arboreum*)
Golden rain tree (*Koelreuteria paniculata*)
Dogwood (*Cornus sp.*)
Magnolia (*Magnolia sp.*)



Shade Trees

Deodar cedar (*Cedrus deodara*)
Zelkova (*Zelkova serrata*)
Hardy rubber tree (*Eucommia ulmoides*)
Beech (*Fagus spp.*)
Elm (disease-tolerant varieties) (*Ulmus spp.*)
Oak willow (*Quercus phellos*)/white swamp (*Q. bicolor*)

Ornamental pear, cherry and plum (*Pyrus sp.*, *Prunus sp.*)

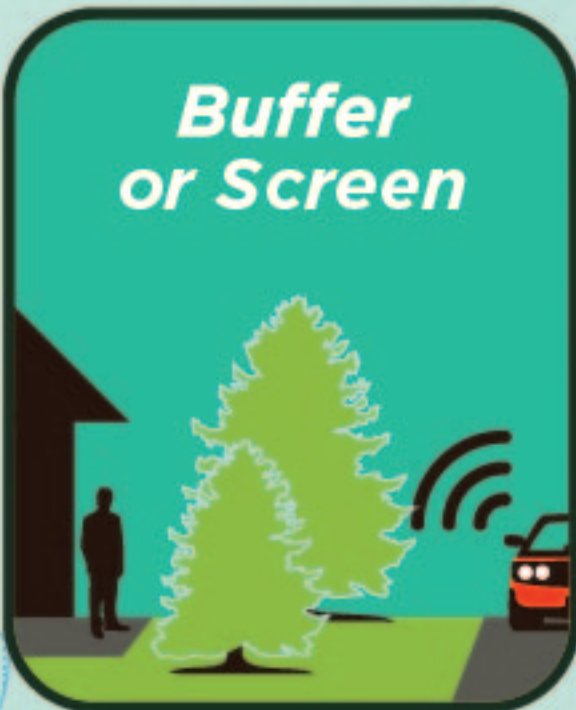
